Stress effects

Is psoriasis related to stress?

Psoriasis is a genetic disease that is exacerbated by stress. Stress-reducing activities such as physical exercise, breathing exercises, yoga, meditation and Tai Chi may be beneficial in lessening stress in predisposed individuals.

After Accutane

How long should you wait after you finish taking Accutane to become pregnant?

You must continue to use two methods of birth control or abstinence to avoid pregnancy, during and for at least one month after discontinuing Accutane. Severe birth defects will develop in women who become pregnant while on Accutane or within one month of stopping Accutane.

Melanoma frequency

How common is melanoma in comparison to other skin cancers?

Over one million new cases of skin cancer will be diagnosed in the United States this year. Melanoma accounts for only 4 percent of skin cancers, but it is responsible for 79 percent of deaths associated with skin cancer. Basal cell carcinoma is the most common skin cancer accounting for 80 percent of cases. Squamous cell carcinoma is responsible for 16 percent of skin cancers. Basal and squamous cell carcinoma have over a 95 percent plain cure

rate if detected and treated early. Melanoma is the most rapidly increasing form of cancer in the United States. In 2002, one in 68 Americans has a lifetime risk of developing invasive melanoma. Melanoma is the fifth most common cancer in men and the sixth most common cancer in women. Lifetime protection from sun exposure through the daily use of sunscreens, sun protective clothing and avoidance of midday sun will lessen one's lifetime risk. Individuals should seek prompt evaluation of any new, irregularly pigmented, changed or symptomatic lesion.

Microdermabrasion

How effective is microdermabrasion as a skin rejuvenation technique?

Although superficial, microdermabrasion does not cause a deep skin injury, studies have demonstrated improvements in skin texture, pigmentation irregularities and fine lines. Histologic studies in individuals who have undergone a series of

treatments have shown thickening of the epidermis, dilatation of blood vessels and increases in collagen deposition. It has been hypothesized that the vacuum pressure alone may be responsible for some of the clinical benefits achieved. Studies are currently underway to investigate this possibility.

Remove it


What is the most effective tattoo removal procedure and how much does it cost?

The most effective tattoo removal procedure is laser. Certain colors such as black, blue and red are more easily removed than purple, orange, yellow and flesh tones. Sometimes it is not possible to achieve complete removal. Tattoo removal always requires multiple sessions and the costs are dependent on the size of the tattoo and the number of treatments required to maximally clear it. Laser sessions generally run between \$300 to \$800 per session and it is not uncommon to require 10 or more sessions to achieve maximal clearing.

Besides Retin-A

I am a fair complected individual with a history of a lot of sun exposure. Dermatologists in the past have recommended that I use Retin-A but my skin cannot tolerate it. Do you have any topical recommendations to improve my skin?
